ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The baseball program features a varsity, JV, and middle school team. The varsity team put together one of its top seasons in 2023 with 12 wins under coach Justin Pollock, which included the team's second-ever state playoff appearance and a win over a #1-ranked opponent.

In the last ten years, the TFS varsity team has had a couple of players earn major recognition; Chathan Clouatre (2020 All-State) & Frankey Moree (2023 Region POY)

The baseball program prepares athletes to be able to play at the next level. 10 players have gone on from TFS to play college baseball.

FACILITIES & TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

The program plays home games at the Higgins Baseball Complex on the Upper School campus. The varsity/JV field is 365 feet in the gaps, and the backdrop beyond the fence from center to right field is a rock staircase. The complex has an indoor hitting facility, and the brand new middle school baseball field sits back behind that. In 2021, the facility upgrades included state-of-the-art LED lighting, a rock staircase beyond center field, and a brand new MS baseball field. The season runs from February through May, and players have access to TFS weight rooms/fitness centers, and field and hitting facility access in the off-season.
