Tallulah Falls School is seeking a full-time Licensed and Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) that comes with flexible hours, a spacious sports medicine room with substantial modalities and recovery tools, as well as future renovation plans. The starting annual salary is \$70,000 with the possibility of higher compensation for those credential leaders with advanced qualifications and experience. The L/ATC of this well-respected program will have opportunities to impact lives, create or strengthen programs and distinctly carve their legacy within the athletic program. In addition, the L/ATC will receive a competitive benefits package including but not limited to; medical/dental/vision/hearing and life insurances, retirement plan (employer match up to 6% after one-year of employment), professional development and employee discount for dependents that attend TFS. # Responsibilities

- Demonstrates skills:
  - o In prevention and care of athletic injuries
  - Use of taping, bracing, and rehab equipment and modalities to return athletes to practice or play
  - o Creating plans for rehabilitation, treatment and care of athletic injuries
  - Evaluation of injuries and first aid
- Educates:
  - o Athletes about their injury, treatment and rehabilitation plans
  - Sets goals for athletes to complete treatment and return to play
- Maintains:
  - o Proper documentation on all athletes
  - o Rapport with coaches/team managers and the setup for hydration, first aid and event protocols as well as with visitors and officials
  - o Coverage for their assigned event, sport or season



- All National Athletic Trainers Association (NATA) and Georgia Athletic Trainers Association (GATA) guidelines for Certified Athletic Trainers and abides by TFS rules and regulations
- Communicates with:
  - o Athletic Director and staff about athletes and their care
  - Parents, dorm staff and upper or middle school staff about accommodations for students with injuries
  - Medical Team for athlete rehab, progress and follow up for return to full participation
  - Athletes about their care, rehabilitation and scheduling for physical therapy, medical appointments, both on and off campus
  - Coaches through injury reporting, emails, and face to face conversations regarding athletes and their return to participation

## **Requirements & Qualifications**

- Licensed in Georgia or eligible for Licensure in Georgia
- NATA/BOC Certified Member
- Bachelor's degree required; master's degree preferred in athletic training dependent upon certification completion.
- Preferred experience in a school setting
- CPR/First Aid/AED certified current
- Valid driver's license
- Maintain a high degree of professionalism
- Understand and value private education, day and boarding student life and academic/athletic balance
- Adhere to and enforce all school policies

## **Standard Physical Requirements:**

- Must be able to sit and/or stand for an extended period of time.
- Must be able to bend, reach, lift and climb.
- Must be able to understand written and verbal instructions.
- Must be able to lift, carry, move and handle equipment, boxes weighing up to 50 pounds
- Must be able to communicate and respond to questions from various levels both within
- and outside the organization.
- Must have manual dexterity sufficient to perform specified duties
